

What a wonderful Saviour is Jesus our Lord! Hoping you all are doing well. This has been an exciting year for us so far, and we are looking forward to what the Lord will do.

In Revelation we read, "I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name." It is encouraging to know, God is still opening doors! He did not stop with Philadelphian church. He is willing and able to make a way for me and for you, if we will keep His word and not deny His name.

It is a great joy to report several more churches that have joined our Support Team: Temple Baptist in Collinsville, VA; Grace Baptist in Newport, NC; Houston Road Baptist in Troutman, NC & Zion Hill Baptist in Bluefield, VA.
It is a blessing to be fellowlabourers with them in a joint effort to reach lost souls for Christ.

As some of you know, I have been in contact with missionaries and pastors in Alaska since we began deputation. This has been an effort on my part to stay connected with our field, and those already labouring there. **Just recently, I received word that there is a remote village in the Southwest area (where God has called us), that needs a preacher.**

I am planning a trip to visit this village during the month of April. I feel God is leading me to do this. I want to remain sensitive to the will of God, whatever that might be. I have said all along that, "Whenever God says it is time to go, we are going to go." If this is that time, then by the grace of God, I am ready.

Please pray for me. I need the wisdom of God to make the right decision.

The community I will be visiting is near other native villages that can be reached with the gospel. It would be my desire to see these evangelized and bible-believing Baptist churches established.

This will be excellent experience for me, especially since I have yet to visit the area of AK where God has called us to, among the Yupik people.

If you have not been to our website lately, please check out some of the new things we have posted there. **We have a new section on our site dealing with "Operation Care Package"** – we would like to get more churches and families personally involved with our ministry, when we get to the field. By having items shipped to us in Alaska, it will save us a great deal of money, since everything is at least 2-3 times the cost in remote Alaska as it is in the Lower 48. If enough interest is generated, and enough folks commit to sending us a package once a year, we would not have to raise as much monthly monetary support.

3. For more churches to step out by faith to take on new missionaries.



THE CAUDLES ARE HEADING NORTH TO ALASKA!

We knew this would be an exciting year, but we had no idea it would be THIS exciting!!!

In our last prayer letter, I spoke of how God opens doors for us, and He does! The Lord has done just that for us. But, it is one thing to have an open door, and another thing to actually go through the door. By God's grace we are going through this open door, trusting Him all the way. "Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it." 1 Thess. 5.24

During the month of April I spent three weeks in Alaska, meeting with pastors and a missionary pilot in the Anchorage area. I also visited the remote town of Dillingham in the Southwest (which is among the Yupik people), that is in need of a preacher. There is a small group of precious believers there, who want us to come. **Not only is there a great need in this hub village, but also to reach the surrounding Native villages with the Gospel and to see churches established.**

After much prayer, seeking the Lord, and seeing God's hand in it all, He has made the way so clear. The Lord has given me complete peace, and a confidence that this is where He wants us to be.

Lord-willing, provided the funds for the move come in, we are planning to arrive in Seattle, WA by August 10th, in order to make the last barge north before winter.

We are currently looking to purchase a pick-up truck and an enclosed trailer. We should be able to cover the cost of the truck and part of the trailer cost. **The expenses of our relocation, not including the vehicle, will be a little more than \$16,000 total.**

If you are interested in an itemized list of the expenses, we can send it to you, or you can visit our website to view the details there.

We are also setting up a "moving fund" with our mission board for any special love offerings towards our relocation costs. You can send your check, made payable to PNBM, making a note in the memo section "Caudle Moving Fund".

We also are in need of churches, families & individuals to sign up for "Operation Care Package". Our website has all the information, and we will mention it again in the near future.

Throughout deputation the Lord has helped us to stay focused on our calling and has kept the burden fresh. But lately, as you can imagine, our excitement level has been sky high! ***We just can't wait to get where God wants us to be and pour our hearts into the ministry!***

We praise the Lord for the sale of our deputation vehicle and for providing us a pick-up truck and an enclosed trailer (debt-free).



The expense of our relocation has come down, but we still need \$13,000 to complete the move before the end of July. We are booked to meet the barge in Seattle by Aug. 11/09.

We will be involved in a VBS this week—please pray that we can be a blessing and that souls will be saved.



Greetings brothers and sisters in the Lord! We rejoice to update you on our move to Alaska. The Lord has provided the needed funds to get us there and we look forward to serving the Lord among the precious souls in Dillingham. "I have put my trust in the Lord God, that I may declare all thy works." Ps. 73:28

We are excited to report that Woodlawn Baptist Church in Rocky Mount, VA and Roberts Memorial Baptist Church in Eden, NC has joined our support team!

We are ready to pull out this Saturday, August 1st. God has provided in an incredible way – we will be on the road for 7 days, and will put our belongings on the barge August 11th, and fly to Anchorage later that day. We should arrive in Dillingham at the end of August.

Please be patient with us about receiving our next prayer letter. **It may be late September or October before we are able to update you again via prayer letter.**

We still need \$2,500 towards our barge fees. We are going to head out to Seattle and put everything on the barge, paying half of the barge fees (\$4,000), and then pay the other half in mid-September when the barge arrives in Dillingham. This will give us an additional month to raise the additional funds.

Any special love offerings can be sent to our moving fund. You can send your check, made payable to PNBM, making a note in the memo section "Caudle Moving Fund".

We have had a few folks contact us about "operation care package" and we pray that this concept will really "take off" not only for our family, but also for other missionary families. It is a wonderful way for families and churches to help missionaries in a tangible and more personal way.

Also, if you have any available tracts or Bibles, we can use them in the ministry in Dillingham. They can be mailed to our PO Box (left column).

Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord, we rejoice to be serving the Lord on the field! Thank you for standing with us. We are excited to see what God is doing and what He will do, if we will only trust and follow Him. There is Hope for the dear souls of Southwest Alaska! "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound." Isaiah 61.1

We are thankful to report that Central Baptist in Eden, NC and Floyd Baptist in Stoneville, NC have joined our Support Team!

We also praise the Lord for bringing our household goods by barge safely from Seattle. We are in the process of getting unpacked and settled.

Please pray that God will give us wisdom. We need to respect the privacy of the community in our prayer letters. Please understand we must remain vague regarding names or information that could compromise our trust with the village.

We have had several visitors at the church lately, which has been a blessing! Some have been curious, others are just passing through, but God is working nonetheless.

One visitor was kind enough to give us canned food and dry goods. Through this act of kindness, God has dealt with my heart about reaching out to our community through food baskets for the sick, grieving, or those new to our community.

I've had the blessed opportunity to have a Bible study with a family in town. Please pray that God may use this to be a help to them.

I am also looking into ministering to the inmates at the local correctional facility. Please pray concerning this.

As some of you know, we came to Alaska by faith, with 50% of our needed support. God has been faithful, and He has provided me with a job at our local hardware store. This job has not only provided the extra money we needed, but has also been invaluable in providing opportunities to meet the people.

Thank you to EVERYONE who has been sending us Care Packages – they are such a help, and each one is a special blessing to us, and our ministry. We just can't thank you enough!

We appreciate your support – each and every one of you are vital to our ministry here.

We must pray one for another – during these difficult economic times, we are aware that some of our churches are struggling financially.


