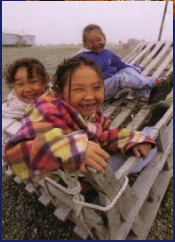
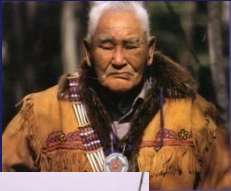

I mentioned in our last prayer letter, the Lord has opened a door for me to preach at our local correctional facility. **I am overjoyed to report that one of the inmates recently trusted Christ as his Saviour!** At the close of this particular service, I gave an invitation and said, "If any of you are serious about giving your whole heart to God, I would like you to stay behind and I will talk with you further."

One gentleman stayed behind. After speaking with him for awhile and listening to his life story, I found out he had been searching for the truth for the past five years. He said, "Yes I am!"** We got down on our knees, I prayed for him first. Then he asked the Lord in his own words to forgive him of his sins and to save his soul. I just about exploded!!! Right now it looks like he is going to be relocated to another village, but pray that we can stay in contact, so that he can be discipled.

We would like to part by leaving you with the assurance that God is at work here in a very real way! We have seen the Lord open doors that in many cases would have taken years to open. We give Him all the praise, because He is the one who is moving in lives, and opening hearts to His Word. We pray God will bring steady progress to the ministry in Dillingham.

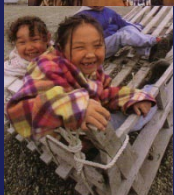

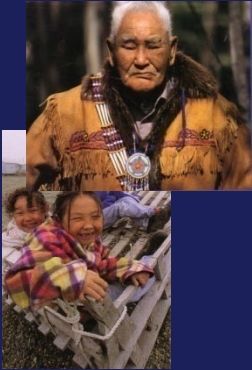

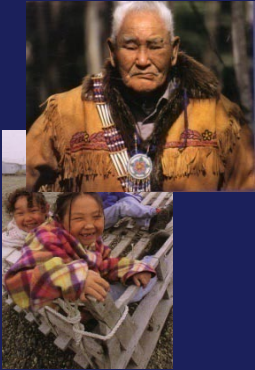

The Lord provided us a shelter to use in one of the neighborhoods, and ***we had anywhere from 20-35 children each day***, as well as a few parents, despite the cold wind and rainy conditions. ***Three precious children prayed to accept Christ.***

The Kids 4 Truth Club started Aug 8th, and it has been exciting to see the kids coming out and enjoying the teaching and activities. Please pray the Lord will continue to grow this ministry.

We will be mailing out a DVD to update you regarding our first year of ministry here in Dillingham. Please be looking for it to arrive within the next 2- 3 weeks.

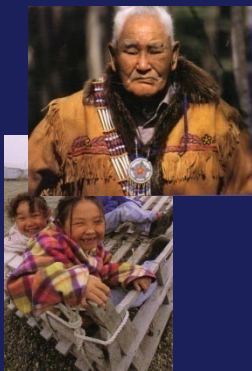

Please pray for the Lord to send more laborers into the villages of SW Alaska.



Our Kids 4 Truth Club children are earning their own Study Bibles, and working with them each week is a real joy for us. Please pray for more children to come out, get saved and grow in the Lord.

Several new visitors have been out to church in the past two months, and one Native man in particular has been coming out since relocating to Dillingham. He claims to know the Lord and I have been meeting together with him for Bible Study/Discipleship each week. Please pray for him, and that others I have invited to the study will come.

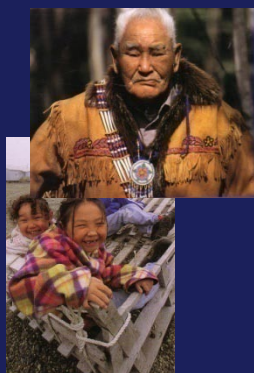

Happy New Year to you all! We hope you had a very Merry Christmas! We rejoice in what God has done over the past year, and we look forward by faith to what he will do in 2011!

We don't want to get in God's way, or limit what He desires to do in the hearts of the Yupik people and the lost souls in Dillingham. I am reminded of what was spoken of the people of Israel in Psalm 78.41 "Yea, they turned back and tempted God, and limited the Holy One of Israel." I want to see God work. He does a much better job than we ever could!

We are blessed to now be a part of the mission effort of the Meadowview Baptist Church in Winston-Salem, NC. Also, an extra special thank you to those who sent us care packages and gifts for Christmas.

Please continue to **pray for the young Native man**, that I have been having Bible studies with. He seems to be really sincere about growing in God's Word.

We were blessed with the opportunity to sing Christmas hymns with our Kids4Truth Club kids at our local nursing home. We practiced for several weeks beforehand, and the kids really did a wonderful job!



I was also able to share a Gospel message with those in attendance. One of the residents repeated over and over how much she enjoyed us coming.

Our Christmas Eve service went really well. The church was packed. We had several visitors, some perhaps hearing a clear Gospel message for the very first time. I preached out of Luke 2.25-35 where Simeon took the Lord up in his arms and blesses God saying, "Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace... For mine eyes have seen thy salvation." There was a lady present and her children who were visiting from a nearby village. This is the same Native lady that Eva had the opportunity to witness to one on one earlier this year. After the service she expressed that she felt that God was speaking to her through the message. Please pray for her salvation.

In early March, we have our "Beaver Round-Up" celebration. Please pray as we reach out to our community through being involved in the parade, handing out tracts along with our Kids 4 Truth Club kids.

Just the other day, a long time 'Dillinghamer' referred to me as a 'local'. That was encouraging! It takes time to build trust with people. With the Lord's help, that is exactly what we want to do. Thank for your prayers and support!
